Read Together God gives us water. Can you point to the water? Water is good to drink. And water is good to take a bath in. Thank You. God. for giving us water.

Bible Words

"God gives me good things" (based on Matthew 7:11).

Say the Bible Words and have your child look in a mirror. Say, "God will give you good things."

Things

to Do Together

God gives me water to drink (pretend to drink) and to wash dishes in my sink. (pretend to wash a dish) The water falls from the sky (wiggle fingers down) to water the flowers so dry. (wigale fingers down)

Helping with Water

Ask your child to help you water plants or give water to your pet. Give your child a cup with some water. Show how to carefully pour the water over a plant or into your pet's water bowl. Remind your child that God gives us water.

Water Play

Have your child sit in the tub. Provide various cups, bowls, and strainers as toys. While playing in the water, talk about how water keeps us clean. Say, "God gives us water. Thank You, God!"
